COVID-19 Health and Safety Plan

Under the guidance of the Pennsylvania Department of Health and the Centers for Disease Control, Community Music School has established the below measures to reopen for in-person instruction when appropriate. As CMS takes the health and wellbeing of our community extremely seriously, we have established protocols that exceed current standards. All CMS staff will be required to earn a certificate by the **American Red Cross in COVID-19 prevention** prior to offering any on-site instruction. In addition to below, our community will see many preventative enhancements to our facility.

- Anyone who exhibits signs of illness or has been exposed to someone exhibiting signs of illness should not attend any CMS in-person instruction.
- Upon entering the building all faculty and students / caregivers must complete quick health certification through registrar.
- Masks/ face covering are required to be worn by all.
- Social distancing practices will be in place when able to do so.
- Personal Protective Equipment has been provided to all staff (face masks, face shields and goggles).
- Plexiglass barriers will separate faculty and students in studio.
- Sanitation procedure in place for instruments and barriers following each lesson.
- To reduce building capacity, one caregiver in building will be permitted at a time if needed to walk student to room, however drop off is encouraged and waiting areas are reduced.
- We encourage students to arrive no more than 5 minutes prior to lesson time.
- Enhanced nightly cleaning procedure will be followed using EPA certified products.
- Faculty and students will be notified immediately of exposure and asked to follow current CDC guidelines for exposure.
- Areas used by an infected person will be cleaned and disinfected before allowing further use.
