COVID-19 Infection Prevention Plan: Updated June 2021

CMS will be mask optional when the Pennsylvania Department of Health lifts the state-wide mask mandate, currently scheduled for June 28<sup>th</sup> or sooner.

As we return to in-person learning, although masks will no longer be required in the building, CMS still takes the health and wellbeing of our community extremely seriously. <u>Individual students and individual faculty members may request each other to wear a mask in studio.</u> Requests can be made through administration. We ask that our full community take into consideration that the average age of our student is below vaccination age, and highly encourage everyone to continue to wear a mask. Anyone who exhibits signs of illness or has been exposed to someone exhibiting signs of illness should not attend any CMS in-person instruction.

- Winds and Voice: Plexiglass barriers will separate faculty and students.
- All wind instruments are required to be fitted with bell covers (provided by CMS).
- Voice will have extensive distancing practices in place.
- Sanitation procedure in place for instruments and barriers following each lesson.
- Ensembles and camps will have distancing practices in place in addition to above.
